In addition to lighting the spark, and cultivating their curiosity and ingenious thinking, learners will understand, through concrete examples, how electric cars and objects powered by artificial intelligence work in their environment.

Students are also invited to reflect on the ethical implications of this advanced technology, an essential dimension that the manual does not neglect.

Beyond learning, this work also inspires the next generation of engineers, thinkers, inventors and leaders who will shape a futuristic society.
